- 3. A tape or CD recording:** Required for adjudication if the piece is not for solo instrument. Also required if the composition will not be presented by live performers at the district recital.
- 4. A check payable to OMTA for the amount due** (see right).

Send the envelope to your OMTA District Composition Celebration Chairperson by the deadline. Late entries may be accepted at his/her discretion.
